

What Drives Health Plan Trend?

- Intensity of Services (New treatments, therapies and technology)
- Medical inflation, Health Provider price increases
- Increased use from aging populations or rise in obesity
- Fee for Service Payment System
- Defensive medicine (e.g., excessive testing)
- Health Provider Consolidation increases costs
- Provider cost shifting from reduced payments by Medicare and Medicaid
- Erosion effect of fixed deductibles and copayments¹

Choice or Provider Networks - Noncompetitive pricing terms


Comparison of Projected to Actual Trends for PPOs For Actives and Retirees Under Age 65: 2012–2021




What Does an 8% Annual Increase Mean?

An 8% increase in plan costs takes away from wage increases, retirement benefits, etc.


Annual medical Plan cost per employee	8% Increase	Plan cost per 1,000 covered lives
\$15,000	\$1,200	\$1.2 million increase to budgets

- Migraines: Nurtec

Specialty:

- Atopic Dermatitis: Dupixent, Rinvoq
- Plaque Psoriasis: Otezla, Sotyktu

Biosimilars:

 Inflammatory Conditions: Humira biosimilars

Ozempic


- A semaglutide injection (0.5, 1, 2 mg) indicated as an adjunct to diet and exercise to improve glycemic control in adults with type 2 diabetes mellitus
- Cost: \$884/ month with discount card ²





Projected Dental and Vision Trends: 2022 and 2023











Projected Impact of No Surprises Act

Top 5 Cost-Management Strategies

Use of healthcare transparency tools

Implement virtual counseling for behavioral health issues

Implementing chronic condition management and digital health coaching for diabetes, hypertension and weight management

Implement virtual physical consultation for primary care

Implement cost-management negotiation service for out-of-network services



Greater transparency about health care costs and quality is the top cost-management strategy for plan sponsors.



Competitive Bidding

The medical provider networks change over time as major networks acquire smaller regional networks, recruit new providers and lose providers over contract disputes.



Revisit Plan Design

Revisit your plan design cost sharing dynamics. Good plan design offer member copay savings when lower costs services or setting are used.



Enhancing High-Cost Claimant Case Management

With healthcare costs being highly driven by a relatively small number of high need individuals, it makes sense to focus on high-cost claimants to reign in healthcare expenses.



Managing Risk

Cancer has overtaken musculoskeletal conditions as the top health care cost driver, with plan sponsors observing more late-stage cancers.



Digital Therapeutics

Plan sponsors considering digital therapeutics for their benefit programs should develop a plan to evaluate these offerings.



Reduce Readmissions

Inpatient hospital admissions typically account for the largest expense component of most health plans. Avoiding readmissions can reduce a substantial portion of hospital expenses for plan sponsors and improve patient outcomes.


Formulary Management

Strategies for Rx Cost Management

Specialty Copay Assistance Programs

- Various types of copay programs available from your PBM or a third party vendor
- May have grandfathering or other compliance implications
- Will Require Plan Document Changes
- Savings can be substantial to plan sponsors with high specialty drug costs

- Preferred specialty management


